State labor convention shows another side of unions

SPEEA labor delegate David Garrett gained a new appreciation of the power of labor unions after attending this year's Washington State Labor Council (WSLC), AFL-CIO convention.

"It was an honor to be there," he said. "Sometimes we get insulated with our union and our workforce. We should take the blinders off and really see what's going on out there. It makes you count your blessings."

Garrett, also a delegate to Snohomish and Island County Labor Council, noted the high caliber of speakers who gave powerful talks about labor rights and working conditions.

Chris Smalls, WSLC's keynote speaker, shared how he organized the first union at Amazon by leafleting at the bus stop across from Amazon for a year. "At first people weren't interested, then as workplace conditions deteriorated, they started to talk to him," Garrett said. Noting the theme of Smalls' talk, 'meeting people where they are at,' Garrett wants to see himself and others do a better job of greeting new hires. "We need to talk to them and welcome them to the union."

Four candidates for state leadership roles also spoke at the convention, which impressed Garrett. "That shows the leverage we have as unions."

As chair of the Northwest Legislative and Public Affairs (L&PA) committee, Garrett's favorite workshop was called "Building

Power Through Politics." He appreciated the discussion on policy and politics, noting policy is a result of politics. "If we want policy changes, we have to play the game."

Garrett also noted a workshop on labor law, featuring lawyers representing labor in the U.S. Supreme Court case of Glacier NW, Inc. v Teamsters. The court's decision affects unions' ability to strike.

"Overall, it was a good experience," said Garrett, who had not attended a state labor convention before. "It was nice to see how all of these unions come together."
