

At their regular meeting, the Council:

Cundiff (secretary).
- Nominated NW Regional Vice President John Dimas for the interim IFPTE SPEEA-Area vice president. Dimas was

the top vote getter.

• Voted on the following motion: NW23-007 - Adjusting the Budget for the MAC Committee - It is moved the NW Council treasurer on behalf of the Membership Activities Committee requests the fiscal year 2024 NW budget be amended to subtract \$1,000 from line item 2.4.1, "Golf Tournament" and create new line item 2.4.8. for "100 Mariners merchandise gift cards," for a total of \$1,000. Key takeaways from APALA national labor convention

TEATTLE - SPEEA members saw another side to labor and the need for solidarity at the Asian Pacific American Labor Alliance (APALA) national convention held in Seattle.

The degree of union busting, especially in Southeast Asia and the Pacific Islands hit home with Everett Council Rep Joseph Pham, one of the SPEEA delegates at the convention. "People get arrested just for fighting for their right for a fair wage," he said.

Raquel P. Cundiff, Northwest Council secretary and Everett Council Rep, came away with similar impressions. "The key takeaway for me is the struggles Filipino labor leaders are experiencing to bring justice and equality to the working environment. Some of the labor leaders have risked their lives," she said.

The convention delegates attended workshops and heard from high-ranking labor leaders, including Washington State Labor Council (WSLC), AFL-CIO President April Sims, and federal elected officials, including U.S. Rep. **Pramila Jayapal** (D-WA).

and international level impressed Pham. "My favorite part was learning about APALA's efforts to help with unfair labor practices worldwide. I thought it was just for the U.S., but one of the workshops was discussing how groups go to Washington, D.C., to lobby for unjust labor practices in the garment industries in Southeast Asia to try to make a difference."

Cundiff appreciated learning more about labor conditions, particularly in the Philippines. "This is my native country and reminded me of the struggles my mom and dad went through when we lived there. I am also impressed with the work being done by APALA chapters to help in my country," she said.

The conference made Cundiff even more grateful and excited to become more involved in the labor movement. She also wants to do more to help raise awareness.

"I am glad I could better understand the struggles they are going through in both the Philippines and the states," she said, noting her highlights. "And I was also glad to appreciate and be proud of the work they are doing and celebrate wins with them."
