IFPTE Local 1921 members vote to approve new contract

TASHINGTON, D.C. - The members of the Government Accountability Office (GAO) Employees Organization, IFPTE Local 1921 recently voted to ratify a new agreement.

GAO, known as the investigative arm of Congress, is an independent, nonpartisan federal agency that supports Congress and works to improve the performance of the federal government through audits, evaluations, analyses and recommendations. GAO Employees Organization includes nearly 2,500 analysts,

auditors, technical specialists and support staff.

"We reached an agreement that incorporates lessons learned from our pandemic work posture. It reflects the fact that for decades GAO employees have not only been located in Washington, but assigned to field offices across the country and accounts for the wide range of work assignments that our members do," said Benjamin Emmel, IFPTE Local 1921 president. Emmel works as a senior analyst for defense capabilities and management.



GAO employees first voted to form a union in 2007 and have improved the initial contract over the years. For example, this new agreement provides multiple flexible work options, including hybrid and remote work options, along with streamlining transfers between GAO locations and providing the agency with new tools to better manage its physical space.

"This agreement will help GAO to continue to be a good steward of taxpayer dollars and a model federal agency," said Emmel. "It continues the spirit of collaboration that GAO is known for and strikes a balance that will provide expanded flexibilities for employees while we continue to meet our mission in serving Congress."

Surveys show strong support for unions, especially among younger Americans

wo separate polls show continuing strong support for unions, especially among Americans under 30, according to the Gallup Poll Social Series poll on unions and education and a poll conducted by GBAO for AFL-CIO's recent State of the Unions.

Nearly 9 in 10 (88%) under the age of 30 view unions favorably, according to both polls.

"Every day, more and more working people are finding out that the labor movement is the solution to low wages and unsafe workplaces, to inequality and discrimination," said **Fred Redmond**, AFL-CIO secretary-treasurer. He joined AFL-CIO President **Liz Shuler** in a State of the Unions address just before Labor Day.

"The idea of a union may sound complicated,

but in reality, unions are just a group of people coming together," said Shuler. "And there is nothing better than finding that power alongside the people we work with and being part of something bigger than ourselves. That's all a union is."
